

An Index to the *Gaster Festschrift*

Volume 5 (1973) of the *Journal of the Ancient Near Eastern Society of Columbia University* was a special issue comprising a *Festschrift* for Professor Theodor H. Gaster. The volume comprised forty-six articles and included a wide variety of subjects and disciplines. The editors appreciated the need to prepare an index for the volume, but limitations of funds, time, and manpower prohibited the preparation of an index at the time of publication. Nevertheless, the continuing need for such an index has been expressed both by readers and reviewers, and an index has finally been compiled.

This index is the product of several collaborators who contributed their efforts gratis so that the *Journal* could publish it. Credits and many thanks therefore belong to Celeste Adams (General Subjects), Stephen A. Garfinkel (Hebrew Bible, Rabbinic references), Edward L. Greenstein (Phoenician), William E. Herbrechtsmeier (General Subjects), Ian Kage (Aramaic, Hebrew), Leon Kassir (Arabic, Egyptian, Ethiopic, South Arabic), Murray H. Lichtenstein (Greek), David Marcus (Syriac, Ugaritic words and references), William Munz (Apocrypha, Pseudopigrapha, Dead Sea Scrolls, New Testament), and Howard Wohl (Akkadian, Sumerian). Celeste Adams and William Herbrechtsmeier collated and standardized the various manuscripts. Finally, Theodore S. Baran did some preliminary work for the index.

It is our sincere hope that, despite any shortcomings, the index will be useful to our readers.

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
